Our Courses

Business Management

This course is for students who want to study business and finance related subjects at university. The depth modules are Business Studies, Accounting and Economics, and the programme has a practical focus applying information to the contemporary global workplace and helping students to develop skills vital for finding jobs in an increasingly competitive market.

Social Sciences

Students wishing to study Economics, Law, Politics or International Relations should choose this course.
